QUALITIES, MANNERS AND ETIQUETTES



he list of divine qualities, one has to imbibe, is fairly long. Included in this list are goodwill, love, unity, faith, etc., among the great ones besides good habits, good manners and etiquettes, which too are to be inculcated deeply. Otherwise, for want of these good manners and habits, the divine virtues, one possesses, shall remain hidden like a light under the bush. Wrong habits and bad manners are harmful to the possessor as well as to the people, who come into contact with him. So, a virtue-seeker gives full attention to learning manners; he does not consider them mere trifles; he is careful in adopting them because he knows that manners reflect one virtue or the other. We shall, now, discuss about some of the manners or forms of etiquette and shall see how they are connected with the main virtues.

The Manner of Talking

Take, for example, the manner of talking. Coming in between two persons while they are talking together, or cutting in before the other person has had his say and, then, putting forth one's own opinion - this denotes deficient powers of endurance and megalomania. One, who lacks endurance and sobriety, starts on his own without hearing out the other person because he has not fully digested what he is going to say; one, who lacks humility, cannot wait for other's permission to speak, whereas gentleness makes one ask to be permitted to express one's opinion on the subject of talk. He, who does not follow even this simple rule of manner or conduct of talking, is definitely conceited, for he regards his views as superior and flings them about at the wrong time.

Lack of Punctuality

Suppose, I have to deliver a speech at a function or at a meeting and I am a habitual late comer. The chairman has come, but I arrived late. It is clear that my behaviour is not quite correct - the chairman is in, but the speaker is not! It bespeaks pride because I do not show respect to the chairman nor value the time of the audience, who have taken the trouble of coming from distant places to hear me. This is lethargy because my



Editorial




e, the people of India, are very fortunate to have lived most of our lives by our age-old traditions, even though these traditional belief systems hail from the path of Devotion (Bhakti). For instance, we celebrate every year Maha Shivratri festival not only in India and Nepal but also in other parts of the world, when people normally visit temples of God Shiva and make their offerings of worship with a lot of love, deep faith, zeal, enthusiasm and devotion. The devotees of God Shiva put on fast, practice celibacy, remain awake throughout the night as a mark of devotion and offer prayers to Him. This year, this auspicious festival will be celebrated on 11th March. Let this year's Maha Shivratri mark a new beginning in our lives by teaching us to be in divine company of the ever-Divine Being, God Shiva, through His remembrance.

God Shiva as the Supreme Soul is the Father of all the human souls. The descent of Him, which is the most important event in the entire world cycle of 5000 years in this world, is gloriously celebrated as Shivratri. It is seen as the most auspicious festival but the devotees are unaware of the significance as how Shivratri is commemorative of God's descent on earth to lead humanity from darkness of ignorance to light of true knowledge.

It is beautiful to note that a majority of people in Bharat have remained true to their faith in the Supreme and loyal to their family traditions for centuries. It is a common belief that the more the celebrations of festivals, observations and different kinds of religious practices are followed with understanding and purity of mind by each

and every religious denomination, the more one's faith in God and goodness will continue to increase and decorate our lives from childhood until eternity.

Mythological stories may not hold sufficient clarity about God Shiva's role as the *Satguru*; but, when we celebrate festivals like Maha



Shivratri, we take the opportunity to reflect on the essence of our traditional beliefs. We know that Bhakti is one way of connecting with the Supreme Being. Our scriptures teach us that it is after many-many lives lived as the devotees that we receive Enlightenment, or better known as "Spiritual Awakening" or "Receiving Gyana". For many births, we have been chanting hymns and prayers, in which we use the words, "Guru Brahma, Guru Vishnu, Guru Maheshwara," followed by "Paar Brahm Parmeshwar..."; but, have we ever reflected on such concepts or thought about the practical and most auspicious era when Incorporeal God Shiva, the Supreme Father of the Hindu Trinity – Brahma, Vishnu and Shankar - and eternal Father-cum-Teachercum-Satguru of the Deities, actually makes His august presence felt on the world drama stage!

No path of Devotion was ever meant to be a destination in itself; it was simply a path to guide the seeker to the final outcome of having performed *Bhakti* for many lives, which is called

'enlightenment' in the form of God's benevolence. Here, at Prajapita Brahma Kumaris Ishwariya Vishwa Vidyalaya, we follow the path of spiritual wisdom as conveyed to us by the Supreme Source: Supreme Father-cum-Supreme Teacher-cum-Satguru, Incorporeal God Shiva Himself, through the chosen bodymedium of an elderly Brahmin, whom the Supreme Being adorns with the name of 'Prajapita Brahma'. 
LOVING TRIBUTE TO B.K. AMIR CHAND



t is neither the life of a mendicant nor the life of hermit (sanyasi). But, it is the life based on higher values, etiquettes and good manners. It is the life of mindfulness and contentment. This path is shown by the Lord. One must live a life of enlightenment, which comes from the Godly knowledge base. The specific knowledge of the self, drama of life, karma philosophy, independence of each and every actor - the role of souls in the field of karma and role of God - give us the precise and detailed knowledge about life. Where from we have come, where we should go back, who is who and what is what in the world is revealed in detail by the Creator Himself. Everybody has freedom to choose their thoughts, words and actions. Each and every actor is important. Even if one actor does not participate, the drama is incomplete. The so called knowledge one gets in the world is not applied on oneself because it mostly pertains to the material or physical world outside. It does not pertain to the inner, spiritual world inside.

In fact, the inner world is the proper world. The Godly knowledge is related to everyday life. When one has got the Godly knowledge, he is supposed to apply this knowledge in everyday life on oneself. The Godly knowledge is quite related to the inner spiritual world. Thus, as the application of the knowledge progresses, such knowledge matures into wisdom and enlightenment, which will manifest in words and actions in one's life. This knowledge gives one a package of code of conduct based on the original existence level – the soul level, soul to

soul relationships, souls and their involvement and interaction in affairs of the world, the relationship of soul with God and so on. This is an attempt by God to restore to the souls their own self-sovereignty.

Neglect of Divine Directions

It has been observed that some of those, who pursue the path, forget sometime the original teachings of God and get trapped in some selfcreated notions and illusions. When they are face to face with bad sanskars or indecent behaviour of co-aspirants or some other Godly instruments, they mistake that situation and try to find some escapades in the name of leaving such people alone. We normally hear such people telling that 'let them do whatever they want, we do not want to associate with such people, they are silly, money-driven and so on' and, thus, neglect the studies, avoid the place of study and also the responsible instruments and other co-aspirants. The reasons further put forth by them are - they are neglected, opposed, criticised, not being treated well, not being given the chance or preference; they are not also consulted and so on and so forth. They forget the fact that such situations are part of the syllabus for the study of Godly knowledge. At that point of time, they forget the fact that God Himself is teaching them and that their relationship is with Him and Him alone and not with those, who appear to be opposing them or ill-treating them. The people, who appear to be opposing, are not, in fact, opposing; but, they are giving an opportunity to learn new lessons on Godly knowledge and Godly life; thus, ultimately, it is a lesson on life.

God has already forewarned us: "You are in the battle field and you are supposed to be in the battle field always. Being in the battle field means you should be well armoured and should be ever ready to wage a war with *Maya* – Illusion". When a person runs away from the

battle field, he is called a coward. If the battle field conditions are not in our favour, we must stay put there and see that the battlefield situation is changed to our favour. Then only we can be called the brave warriors. The knowledge that is being given by God is to be applied then and there. Application of the knowledge and the experiences gained thereon are going to create greater maturity and understanding. Other people, events, situations, problems, environment, etc. are the examiners. Examination is at every step. When a person keeps himself away from the field of study, which is also the field of battle, how can one prosecute his studies, fight out the battle and pass the examination?

Similar Situations in Worldly Life

Even in worldly (*laukik*) life, people face such situations. In all fields of life, people come with a lot of commitment and hard work where they had faced a lot of problems. The eldest of the famous Hinduja brothers has written a book entitled *Success Story*. The preface of the book reads: "I dedicate this book to all those people, who have pulled my legs and who had created a lot of problems in my life, but for those people I have become the Hinduja of today." One, who is determined and has a specific vision and mission, never looks back. He races through the mist and fog and achieves greatness.

We can take the case of political leaders. They are in a battle field of life for achieving something great and worthwhile in this world. They are subjected to severe criticisms, maligning, character assassinations, leg pulling and life threats and so on. Still, they never leave the battle field. After years of efforts and struggles, they become a member of a local body, an MLA or MP or a Minister. There are many political leaders, who, after years of struggles, could not get any post or position and,

still then, they have been in the battle field and have never left the field. In fact, those, who have left the field and their political parties, could not get anywhere and their lifetime efforts were a futile exercise.

The situations faced in family life are also not different. If a wife or husband finds that the partner is not cooperative or not giving love and affection or not giving respect and regard, etc., such partner may not necessarily opt to get out of the family. They remain in the family because they have got duties and responsibilities to be fulfilled and, as time passes by, situations also change. Political life has a code of conduct, family life has a code of conduct and each and every member has to maintain the self-discipline by following this code. Every member has to conduct himself/herself within the personal space he or she is supposed to use. Just like in a traffic flow, every vehicle has to maintain its space and if the space is violated there is likelihood of an accident. In human life also, there is a specific space for every body and if that space is violated it will result in a sin and thereby giving rise to worries and anxieties.

Need for Introspection

God, the Supreme, is the Ocean of Light and Spiritual Might. His instructions, advices, orders and guidelines are parts of the great spiritual study. The aspirants are bound to follow the path of knowledge step by step. His divine directions (*Shreemat*) are the benchmarks. The moment the aspirants start manipulating and interfering with the divine directions and become careless in following the directions, they start losing the ground. Rajyoga is the loveful remembrance of God through which the aspirants get enthusiasm, zeal and passion to foster constant remembrance and also maintain close relationship with the Lord. The practice of yoga is the spiritual effort, which binds the aspirants with

the Lord. Those, who practise yoga, outlive the perennial worldly (*laukik*) human relationships, which were in a way crude bondage. In fact, they were trapped in attraction of bodies of other human beings. The technique of yoga has helped them to get out of the traps and, now, they feel freedom to think, speak and move around.

But, this freedom is not safeguarded constantly due to the reason that they start manipulating, overlooking and disregarding the divine directions and remonstrance. They also start forgetting the Lord, who was their very life and was everything for them when they started their spiritual journey. When they first started, they had set a great vision, and that vision was being translated into practical terms as their experience of supersensuous joy, happiness and peace had increased by leaps and bounds. They were enriching in all fields of life. There were many positive welcome transformations taking place in their relationship with others, the stress-free way in which they had dealt with the problems and also conducted their everyday life with peace and satisfaction. But, the moment they started looking at others, their life started moving to a different direction. They started picking up holes in others' coats, criticising others, branding them as bad and so on. In the process, they left the morning amritvela meditation session, the morning spiritual discourse and the service programme, which had, in fact, enhanced their capacity to coexist and live together in a context of diversities in the past. They started neglecting the Godly lifestyle practices - the dos and don'ts. Such aspirants get isolated when illusions play the fiddle and they start dancing to their tunes. The battle, thus, starts.

In fact, this is an occasion for all of them to introspect and correct themselves instead of

blaming others and complaining about them. They must become constructive and creative thinkers. Such churning will enlighten them and guide them properly. They must recall those days when they first came to the abode of God, their experiences they got then and their convictions of the relationship they had with the Lord. They had convinced themselves then that God and His mission were the focus of their life. They are bound to be thankful and grateful to the Lord for all that enlightenment He has bestowed on them. It is not that human beings matter in this case. It is the Lord and His great mission and perusal of a life of great achievement that should matter to them. They should review their 'value system' and 'revalidate' their stand on Godly life.

Realisation and Re-alignment

We all have a moral responsibility to see that God's mission on earth is fulfilled with satisfaction and we should stay with Him to the last moment. We should not be dropouts of the great school of spiritual study, which God Himself has introduced, where the Lord Himself is the Supreme Teacher and *Satguru*. We are hand in hand with the Lord. We should not put forth lame excuses and sidetrack. We should not cheat and breach the trust of all those souls, who believed in us and have kept faith in us. We should never leave the battle field. We should be part of the game. We must be active players.

Just because some of the co-aspirants appear to oppose us, we should not become traitors. Some of us might have the impression that if we oppose and put obstacles in the *Yagya* by creating a separate outfit and all that, then, the co-aspirants and responsible instruments, who opposed us, will learn a lesson. It is rather a better option that instead of having such a negative impression, we should start asserting our point of view and try to remain in the battle

field. There are many alternative ways of dealing with a situation by remaining in the field. But, instead of that, we indirectly become the stumbling blocks in the *Yagya*. In reality, in this way, we oppose God and His great mission. We are thereby committing a great sin.

We are the souls, who should safeguard the Yaqya and maintain this to the last moment by being the right hand of the Lord. We must identify our self-created weaknesses and patch the leakages and remove the blocks. The Maya - Illusion - will force us to leave the hand of the Lord. Never leave the hand of the Lord. Tighten the grip by moving around with Him always. We all have the practical experience of the simple loveful remembrance of Him and have the enlightenment that His remembrance is the panacea for all ills in our own life and the innumerable problems in the world. Similarly, the knowledge bestowed and blessed upon us by Him is a great power, which enables us to overcome any problems in life. Therefore, postpone all the temptations, inflated ego syndromes and all false prestige issues for execution at a later date. Then, we will ultimately win the race. HAPPY HOLI - THE FESTIVAL OF SPRING, COLOURS AND LOVE

oli is a popular ancient Hindu festival originating from the Indian subcontinent. It is also known as the festival of spring, festival of colours or festival of love. In West Bengal, it is named as Basanto utsav as introduced by the world poet R.N. Tagore at Shantiniketan. It is predominantly celebrated in India but has also been spread to other parts of Asia and the Western world. The Holi festival signifies the arrival of the best spring season blossoming love in hearts at the end of winter. After observance of Maha Shivaratri in Shiva Chaturdashi a day before the new moon in Falguna month, Holi comes 15 days later in the full moon day of the same month in Falguna Purnima. According to the Vikram Samvat calendar initiated by Maharaja Vikramaditya, Falguna is the end of the year and the then New Year starts from Chaitra. In true sense of the term, Holi signifies the end of Kaliyuga and a fresh start of Satyuga. Holi is very special in this sense that there is no obligation by means of any worship, sacrifice, chanting of mantras or oblation as required in majority of festivals. It is a day of full enjoyment with colours along with some festive activities and a day to celebrate joyously by getting together in monotonous life, to get rid of past errors, to end conflict, to forgive and forget and to repair our broken human relationships. In many places, Holi is celebrated for 1 or 2 days and in a few places like Brajadham, i.e., Mathura and Vrindavan, it is a 7-day ceremony.

According to legend *Vishnu Puran*, *Holi* is celebrated as a festival of triumph of good over

evil in honour of god Vishnu and his devoted follower *Prahlada*. There is a mythological story which states that the demon Hiranyakashyap subjected his son *Prahlada* to cruel punishment for being a devotee of Vishnu. Holika, the sister of Hiranyakashyap, tricked Prahlada for sitting on a pyre with her. She was wearing a fire-proof cloak and Prahlada was without any such garment. As the fire roared, the cloak flew from Holika and encased Prahlada, who survived while Holika was burnt alive. For this reason, the first evening of *Holi* is celebrated as burning of Holika (Holika Dahan) when people gather in a place and perform rituals in front of the bonfire; and, along with burning of waste materials, they also pray that their inner evils should be destroyed in the way Holika was burnt into ashes. The fire, which shines with its brilliance on Holi, decomposes the raja-tama particles in the atmosphere and this helps activate various deities in the form of colours. This bliss is celebrated symbolically by throwing colours in the air. The following day is celebrated as Rangoli or Fagua, a free-for-all festival of colours where people smear one another with different colours. People visit family, friends and even foes to show love through colours either in powder form or mixing them in water and, then, share sweets with each other and one another.

As per *Krishna* legend, *Holi* is celebrated in Brajadham, where *Krishna* was supposed to grow up, in commemoration of the mutual divine love of *Radha* and *Krishna*. People everywhere celebrate the day by throwing red-rose fragrant powders (Gulal) and splashing odorous coloured waters. The children and young people form groups armed with dry colours, coloured solutions and water goons (*Pichkaris*), water balloons filled with coloured water. Different groups perform by singing *Holi* songs and dancing and some by playing drums and *dholok*. In Brajadham, the *Holi* festival lasts for a week.

When an angry man defames and insults you, donate him the virtue of your tolerance.

The rituals go beyond playing with colours and include a day where men go around with shields and women have the right to playfully beat them on their shields with stick.

In a spiritual sense, at the time of burning of *Holika*, we burn all our wastes and negativities for the sake of preparing ourselves for the forth-



coming Golden Age. Spiritually, *Holi* has a deeper meaning to celebrate the changing time, i.e., the time of a great shift of the present vicious world into virtuous one by means of spirituial transformation of the whole human society. **God Shiva Himself has revealed the actual meaning of** *Holi* **in three ways as follows:**

- (I) The term Holi means that anything or matter, which is past, is not to be kept in memory and we should not think about it again. It hints us to make a full stop to the past and move ahead to accomplish the busy schedule of life in easy manner in remembrance of God.
- (ii)The term Ho-li means "I became the own child of God, i.e., I should be always connected with Him and be within His umbrella of grace and protection. In this precious time of Diamond Age (Sangamyuga), whatever we do, we should complete the same with the awareness of Godly directions but never with

- our prejudiced decisions, our own or others, inflicted with vices.
- (iii)The term *Holi* means holy or pure. Whatever work we do should be with the help of divine intellect, not with demonic directions.

Holi is definitely the festival of colours, but in which colour will we paint ourselves - only with material colours or with the colour of original qualities of the souls? In the present world, every human is painted with many types of colours i.e. wealth, name, fame, prestige and different vices like lust, anger, greed, ego, anger etc. As we do not know God and not only that, we are suspicious about God & His true identity and always argue about the matter of spiritual essence of any festival. We hardly think about our mental progression and to be equipped with positive & powerful thoughts. We are always busy with futile things connected with material progression and hence in every moment Maya Ravana is hopping us all. Now the time has come to know the actual facts linked with such a festival like Holi. We even spend the holiday of Holi in unholy way without knowing its true meaning and we just try to enjoy the day/days to fulfil some evil desires of being revengeful & attracted with sensual pleasures through harmful colours, bad manners and impure food & drinks. We never try to make our souls colourful with the colours of power, purity, joy, peace, love, truth & bliss so that we may be liberated from our bondages created by our own karma as per the Law of Karmic Account. Besides Godly knowledge & love for Him, nothing is possible in one's life. The more we avoid the things to celebrate in its original meaning, the more we will be back and lose ourselves day by day. We know that there is no peace & happiness outside, still we beg the same from others. Since Dwaparyuga, we have been losing our inner

qualities which have been captured by *Ravana*, the demon king of vices. Since that time, we are just following the religious practices, rituals i.e. fasting, worship, sacrifice etc, but in no way we cannot unearth the truth behind the same. Many times originality has also gone away from the hymns or scripts in the way of modification by different hands while narrating the same. In *Purans* and myths, there are always exaggerations in different ways to satisfy their own needs in narrow sense. But still if we search, we must find at least some truth inside any occasion.

So the most necessitate thing for us at present is to colour our souls with the loving colours of God and also to make others colourful with the same for its stay permanently within the souls. First half of the 5000-year old Kalpa i.e. Satyuga & Tretayuga is called the Day of Brahma when the deity souls remain in soul conscious colourful state and the 2nd half of the *Kalpa* is called the Night of Brahma when the human souls become infected with vices. Since then the true colours have gone and we have started celebrating the festivals with material colours only, may be synthetic or ecofriendly. When God descends on this earth, we again make ourselves colourful with the original qualities of the soul and this is called true Holi. We celebrate the decendence of God Shiva as Shivaratri and hence, Holi is being celebrated in the same month of Falguna immediately after Maha Shivaratri. Holi is not only to throw the material colours in the clothes & bodies, but to spread others the colours of knowledge & qualities. Holi is to donate unconditional love & very best wishes to self & others. It is also not only an enjoyment to swing loving Krishna in cradle, but also to know the true facts behind the birth of Krishna who will be the first prince of Golden Age and at the same time to acquire the

qualities of him to spend the days in the next coming heavenly world, now under construction, with super sensuous joy & pleasure. We are going to celebrate *Holi* accordingly being holy in mind & action. ❖

URGENT NEED FOR PRACTISING SPIRITUALITY

he want of the people to remain always happy may be fulfilled by practising spirituality. 'Practising spirituality' may be defined as an application of spiritual values and powers in human behaviour as well as awakening and strengthening the spirit by acquiring spiritual knowledge and practice of meditation. It is not an obstruction; rather, actually, it is helpful in the performance of one's duties and in earning of wealth but through fair means only. Of course, there should not be lust or any objective for blind accumulation of wealth. The goal of life should be to achieve perfection in values and powers, which is possible only through practising spirituality. Since spirituality is found common and hidden amongst all the religions, it may be pursued by all individuals to make the earth a better place for eternal peace and happy living for all.

As per the Law of Karma, a state of permanent happiness depends on distancing oneself from bad or sinful acts, and on doing always good deeds in the form of good and positive thoughts, words and deeds. Knowingly or unknowingly, we keep on doing wrong acts under the influence of the five vices commonly known as lust (Kama), anger (Krodha), greed (Lobha), attachment (Moha), and ego (Ahankar) and also desire for limitless wants. For instance, under the influence of ego, if you rebuke a worker working under your supervision in a normal way, who gets hurt, you have committed a sin of which you are unaware. Practising spirituality expands the field of our awareness and makes us awakened and, then and thereby, we may stop doing sinful acts.

People, generally, decide the goodness or badness of their actions, in a given situation, on the basis of their conscience or inner voice of the soul. As regard bad Karmas, our souls warn us not to do them; but, unfortunately, in most of the cases, we don't listen to those promptings of our conscience or hidden voices. For instance, in cases of the acts of theft, bribery, favoritism, scandals, adulteration, corruptions, etc. people act against the inner voice of their souls. In most cases, the inner voice or spark is too weak to check the bad deeds, because the strong temptations of the five vices and desire for limitless wants overpower or cover it immediately and extinct the spark abruptly. It is like a glowworm or firefly, which twinkles momentarily only and fails to remove the darkness of the night. Therefore, to do good deeds and to remain always happy, it is required to empower and strengthen the soul so that it may grow from a spark to a lamp and, then, to an ever burning flame, on the one hand, and to remove the five vices and unnecessary wants, on the other. By practising spirituality daily, we may achieve both these goals just like killing two birds with one stone.

Values, virtues and powers like peace, purity, happiness, bliss, love, perseverance, contentment, forgiveness, concentration, etc. reside in the soul and not in human body. The soul and body are two separate entities. The soul is an eternal point of conscient energy, which is the master of the body and the body is constituted of five elements of the Nature. The aforesaid invaluable jewels such as values, virtues and powers are not only inexhaustible source of happiness but they also accompany the soul as *Sanskaras* for the next rebirth. These cannot be purchased from the market at any price but they may easily be gained by practising spirituality regularly and patiently for long.



Late Rajyogini Dadi Janki (1916-2020):

A WORLD SPIRITUAL LEADER

orn on 1st January, 1916, in Hyderabad, at present the part of Sindh province of Pakistan, Dadi Janki opted for herself the path of spirituality, divinity and philosophy of the soul, as early as in her youth at 21. This venture made her travel through the Western countries during the 1970s to spread the Indian Philosophy, Rajyoga education, Values and Spirituality, and to found service centers of Prajapita Brahma Kumaris Ishwariya Vishwa Vidyalaya, in more than 140 countries.

A world spiritual leader and head of the Brahma Kumaris, she passed away on March 27, 2020. Dadi was 104 years old. Though she has departed physically, her inspiring words still echo in the hearts of millions of spiritual



seekers. It is wonderful that her formal education was up to third standard; but, with her sincerity, dedication and multi-fold magnanimity, she made the humanity grow in spirit widely.

She was powerful and inspiring! She was able to change the vision and attitude of those, who felt gloomy. She instilled positivity in everybody. She led others to the depths of the ocean of wisdom on the basis of her experiences. Her motto was: the world is one family (Vasudaivakutumbakam)!

In 1974, she started the services of Brahma Kumaris outside India, in London. Her renunciation and love for God gave her the strength to spread God's message throughout the world. She stayed outside India for 33 years till 2007. Since then till 2020, she was at Mount Abu, Rajasthan India as the Chief Administrative Head of the Brahma Kumaris Organization.

Her vision was that whether it is a temple, mosque or church, it should give the feeling of a home to those who enter there. One, who enters the B.K. Global Head Quarters at Mount Abu also feels the same that they are at home and it is their real home!

She would never consider herself as busy and was wise enough to never consider responsibility as a burden. She taught simplicity!

In 2015, when she was nominated as the Brand Ambassador for *Swachh* Bharat Mission, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shree Narendra Modi said, "She sacrificed her life to bring positive change in the lives of others."

In the words of Rajyogini Dadi Janki, "Imbibe what Baba says and your face will shine! Baba is making us as great as Himself. We should have the attitude of renunciation (tyaga) and meditation (tapasya) and, then, service (seva) will happen automatically. Churn the knowledge imparted by Him. Our intoxication is incognito. Baba is Karankaravanhar and we are karanhar. He can do His work through us. Let others experience Baba's love through us. Leave all traces of Maya."

She showed us how to live with love and ultimately how to die with dignity. The best tribute that we all can give to such an *Adi Ratan* like Dadi Janki is: Let us reach our final destination of the angelic life and become complete like Father. ❖

GODLY LOVE: MEANS TO DEFEAT MAYA OF 'NAME' AND 'FORM'

e all Brahmins undoubtedly acknowledge that Baba is the best Teacher and Murli is the best source of knowledge. Through these Murlis, the Supreme Being, Shiva Baba, is doing the wonderful task of transforming us from ordinary human beings into deities. Every word of Murli is like a jewel of wisdom carrying deep meaning. The best teacher never utters even a single word without any significance. If he repeats something frequently, there must be a reason for that. Either the students have not realized its true significance or they might have neglected or repeated the mistakes being unaware of its serious consequences. For example, Baba frequently warns us not to be trapped by someone's 'name' and 'form' or not to be attached to anyone except Him. Why does He repeat it so frequently? Being the Ocean of Knowledge, He knows that some children are neither following this Shreemat properly nor have they understood the grave consequences of their failure to follow this.

In the Avyakt Murli entitled "Signs of Sada Suhagin" (dated 28-4-77), God Shiva says,

"Just, talk to Me only, listen to Me only and speak what only I say'this is the stage of *Sada Suhagin*. This type of *Sada Suhagin* will not remember any other soul even for one second, that is no attachment for any bodily being even in



thought. Attachment means not even any sort of inclination towards any object or person. Just as

even in *laukik* life also, to think of other person or even to dream of him is considered as a great sin for Suhagin, like that in alaukik life also if even in thought, even in dream there is any inclination or leaning towards a bodily being, then, it would be considered a great sin for Sada Suhagin. So Sada Suhagin means one Father none other". The day Baba adopted us, we surrendered our body-mind-wealth, even every breath, thought and relationship to Him. Then, how can we use them for something or somebody else? But, that is not the case. As Baba says, because of unstable mind, wandering intellect and old sanskars, some children breach this Shreemat of remembering only One Father and get trapped by the Maya of 'name' and 'form'.

What is there in this *Maya* that takes the children away from God? Let us compare and contrast the relationship with the Supreme Soul and with that of bodily beings in terms of some common factors like beauty, availability, security, stability, reliability, confidentiality and emergency. Baba tells us not to be trapped by name and form of anyone. As far as 'beauty' is concerned, can anyone be really considered more beautiful than the Supreme Soul? Human beauty is subjected to time, temporary and fluctuates but God's beauty, who is the Purest of all, is untouched by ill will or time. In so far as 'name' is concerned, is there anybody in this world whose name is better known than God? When God Himself is offering His love to us in this Confluence Age, does it make any sense to be trapped by the love for name and form of anyone else?

Let us check the factor of 'availability'. When somebody is in love with someone, he or she wants to be with that person all the time. But, is it literally possible to be together all the time with any bodily being? The answer is an emphatic 'No'. But, it is always possible to be with God all the time no matter wherever we

go. People tend to romanticize the act of holding hands and looking at the eyes of their companions. Holding God's hand gives us the feeling of protection and beautiful companionship. Also, for how long one can look at somebody's eyes and what will be the consequences? But, we can take drishti from Baba for hours together and feel empowered, loved and purified.

Except God, everything else in this world is in a state of flux, as nothing is stable. We cannot expect a stable human relationship for a long time because it changes according to the changing moods and feelings, situations and time. There is only one relationship, which is constant and consistent - the relationship of the soul with the Supreme Soul. One cannot hold anybody as mine and mine only except Baba. In the Sangam Yuga, Baba is constantly with us. So, should we nurture the so called love for bodily being, which is perishable and which will lead us to the garden of sorrow? Or should we strengthen the imperishable divine relationship with Baba, which will make us the masters of the world?

In case of 'confidentiality, reliability and patience', can any human being be a better listener than God? Can we share our every thought, emotion, dreams without any hesitation to anybody else except God? Even if we share, there is no guarantee that it will be confined to that person only. But, in case of Baba, He not only listens to us patiently, keeps it to Him only but also guides us with unconditional love and power. No matter how much one tends to romanticize human relationships and remember each other, but in time of extreme danger when no human can help us, whom do we remember? Only God becomes the ultimate source of support in such moments. So, the relationship with God is the best relationship in terms of beauty, availability, co-operation, stability, reliability, security, confidentiality and support.

If one wants to go to Delhi, can the person reach his destination by boarding a flight or train to Karnataka? It will be entirely in the opposite direction. In this spiritual journey, remembering some embodied being is like going in the opposite direction. In this Confluence Age, God has come to make us pure from impure (*Patit se Pavan*). It is the main objective of all His teachings. He Himself says, "The more you remember Me, the purer you will become as I am the Supreme Source of Purity."

Baba has always taught us to renounce the limited and to lead a life of unlimited disinterest (behad ke vairagya). When we read the history of this world, we see that great persons have always renounced everything that is limited in order to achieve something great. Chanakya also taught Chandragupta that to be attracted by someone or to be in so-called love is meant only for common people but not for heroes, who have devoted their life for materializing the dream of Undivided Bharat. This is merely an infatuation, which would result in the downfall of heroes and, then, of the society. History is replete with many such examples when the whole society suffered due to the leaders and the kings, who forgot their duties and indulged in sense gratification. On the other hand, there are examples of great personalities like Swami Vivekananda and Mahatma Gandhi, who took the responsibility of social transformation, led a pure life and contributed a lot to the society. What's about Baba's children? Baba has made us the instruments of such a great task, which even these great personalities could not even think of to transform this hell into heaven, which includes total purification of all souls and the entire natural elements. It's such a mammoth task beyond

imagination of any worldly human being!

Now, how can we really afford to use our mind and intellect, which are already surrendered to Baba for this task, to indulge in anything that is limited? If we do so, what will be the consequences? here are people who say, "There is no absolute truth. There is only your truth" (Debasish Mridha). The same view is expressed in 'Human, All Too Human: A Book for Free Spirits,' which is written by Friedrich Nietzsche.

Yet, we find all the stories and epics presenting, behind the details, the same truth: "Adharma never wins and Dharma never ends (love of truth, honoring the fabric of life)" . If one member behaves dishonestly or says untruth, he will severely be punished by the gang-leader, which shows that truth exists everywhere and is same for everyone. If truth prevails in larger scale, this shows that the ultimate truth exists. This is expressed in a beautiful poem: "God's in His Heaven/All's right with the world!" (It is an excerpt from a famous poetic piece entitled Pippa's Passes by English poet Robert Browning). The attitude of the little girl, Pippa, leads us to the existence of the ultimate truth. In her attitude, one can see the abundance of God-made provisions for life's sustenance and enjoyment, which will be renewed by God whenever they are depleted/destroyed by human greed. In other words, when each cycle of history begins, God gives a perfect start but, later, humans gradually transform it into a hell through their greed; then, God renews it again, and the cycle repeats. This is the ultimate truth. That means there are plenty of proofs for the fact that things were better and better when we go deeper and deeper into the past.

Proofs for things that were once good

- i) All religions started with the spirit of Fatherhood of God and Brotherhood of Man; and, later, they become road-dividers in the end.
- ii) Each word of Sanskrit language was designed in such a way that the user was reminded to be a spiritual, caring and good person. And, unfortunately and ironically, this superb language has almost been abandoned.
- iii) Hospitals were started as charity to remove pain and secure health. But, now, they have become purely commercial. When my friend was involved in a road accident and was taken to the nearby hospital, the hospital athorities refused to start treatment until any of his relatives came and took the security amount first. Fortunately, he had someone to come forward immediately. But, there are many unfortunate cases in which the patients suffer.
- iv) Even the science of Newton's time was to "glorify God". The greatest scientist of all times, Newton wrote this in his Principia Mathematical: "Now, science has almost gone into the hands of people who believe that blind chemicals formed themselves into this wonderful drama of life simultaneously making environment favorable for life and making provisions for life's sustenance and enjoyment."
- v) The Gurukula Education system existed in the first half of the cycle. Its aim was to teach students the art of living as One World Family. In other words, spirituality was the primary aim of education. Now, it has deteriorated into materialistic education. In many places, students come to schools with guns. Look at the alarming number of education campus murders that take place

around the globe.

vi) In ancient times, things such as river, cows, etc., were shown as being worshipped, which meant people took good care of resources – both the inanimate and animate. Now, we are exploiting the resources to the extent that Nature has turned to be wrathful and revengeful against us through various forms of natural calamities with increasing frequency and intensity. "Incredible and abnormal" temperature is being recorded in Antartic, thereby making the sea-level rise, which is a death-dealing reality in the very near future. (Antarctic temperature rises above 20°C for the first time on record. When technologists, in the name of development, added poisonous gases (such as CO2 emission) into the air we breathe, and replaced the life-sustaining forests with concrete jungle ("as the size of Britain annually," the earth loses an area of forest equal to the size of Britain each year with more than 64 million acres of trees lost annually since 2014, the report warns), they believed that nothing would happen to air or water. They also did not know that such ruination of the environment would increase casualties resulting from diseases. It was too late that we realize that "higher mortality" of the pandemic COVID-19 is linked with "a high level of pollution." (Is air pollution making the corona virus pandemic even more deadly?)

But, God knew it will "ruin the earth" causing many adversities such as "pandemics" and "sea-level rise", threatening lives on earth, (*The Bible*, Revelation 11:18; Luke 21:11, 25). Such ruination of environment (the root of which is moral degradation) has happened many times in

the past towards the end of each *Kalpa* (period of around 5,000 years), and God has recreated the New World many times, and it will happen many times in the future too, says the Supreme Father God Shiva (*The Bhagavat Gita* 4:7, 8).

The above facts show that every time when each cycle of history starts, it is heaven on earth and, then, it deteriorates into hell, as we find today. In the first half of the cycle, everyone is 'essence-oriented', treating everyone as an inner spiritual being in outer physical outfit; hence, they adopted the great attitude of One God and One-World-Family. In contrast, in the second half of the cycle, people are mostly 'detail-oriented' contracted into bodyconsciousness, thinking in terms of "my and my family," thus, putting the interest of "mine and my family" above others.

When a person attaches himself with material things and persons that come and go, he is like a person, who falls unconscious toward the more important things such as the soul and the Supreme Soul, our Supreme Father. In passionate affection (raga) and aversion (dvesha), one becomes blind to the reality. Thus, attachment became one of the five vices because in attachment one is unconscious of the greater reality of God and His will for us and is always conscious about his interest in this world. When a person goes deeper and deeper with his/her attachment, he/she comes to realize his/her folly in the end, which means his/her attachment (moha) suffers decay (kshaya). The combination of these two words make the word moksha, which literally means liberation. Thus, the word moksha originally meant freeing oneself from the worldly attachments and aligning the self with God alone as the concluding command given in The Bhagavat

Giving to others without expecting anything in return is a noble virtue.

Gita (18:66): "Take refuge in Me alone. I will liberate you from all inauspiciousness; do not grieve." Thus, moksha means displaying a balanced attitude, while living here on earth, towards life, giving more importance to God and His will for us, which is like living a Golden-aged life. This is what makes one qualified for inheriting the Golden Age of Heaven, which God recreates after the end of Kaliyuga. In the new heavenly world, God recreates adequate provisions for life's sustenance and enjoyment.

When humans make use of these provisions for life's sustenance and enjoyment, they are like 'hung on the proof for the existence of God'. Blind chemicals will not form themselves into such abundant provisions for life's sustenance and enjoyment, nor will they make the environment favorable for life either. Why? Because, as we saw above, the intelligent humans could only spoil the perfect ecosystem and send thousands of species into extinction, which will soon pave the way for extinction of human species themselves. The question -'What is the proof for the existence of God?' – arises because of faulty reasoning of the materialists and evolutionists. They say that life, provisions for life's sustenance and enjoyment, and environment are being made favourable for life and all can be explained with natural causes, without the concept of God. This is a faulty reasoning. If you dismantle a car and reassemble it - it only means you know how a car functions; but, it doesn't mean there is no proof for the existence of a car-manufacturer. Similarly, the evolutionists too made a false reasoning, saying human beings and apes are the evolutions from a common ancestor. It is true that "humans and chimps share a surprising 98.8 percent of their DNA" (DNA: Comparing Humans and Chimps | AMNH). But, they ignore the huge difference between what humans accomplish and what chimps accomplish. All the accomplishments humanity has made so far are because of that slight difference.

When God causes the wonderful drama of life on earth with millions of species, each species has to be different from the other. This means God would see that the DNA of each species is slightly different from the other - just like atomic number, which determines the identity of an element and many of its chemical properties slightly differ from one another [as atomic number of gold is 79, atomic number of mercury is 80, etc.] This cannot be interpreted as one evolving from the other. Resemblance means resemblance, not evolution. Interestingly, such false reasoning of our period, too, is predicted in the Scriptures as part of signs of the Last Days: "Science will be contaminated by speculative interpretations of the atheists" (Shreemad Bhagavatam: 12.3.32).

Thus, when each cycle of history begins, God gives a perfect start; but, later humans gradually transform it into a hell through his greed; and God renews it again, and the cycle repeats. This is the ultimate truth. Now, deterioration is so overwhelming that everyone knows solution to all our problems lies in return to the vision of One God and One-World-Family. Yet, if this is mentioned, many would respond saying it is not practical. But, the above mentioned things show that things were perfect in the beginning; and it can also be made perfect by God any number of times as the need arises.

In other words, entropy is a fact of life, and the Almighty Father, God Shiva, keeps the balance by establishing the New World whenever it calls for. This is the ultimate truth. •

THE DIVINE KNOWLEDGE HELPS TO SHAVE OFF THE LAYERS OF IGNORANCE

ccording to George Bernard Shaw, "A learned man is an idler who kills time in study. Beware of his false knowledge; it is more dangerous than ignorance."

Universal consciousness is the seed of allpervading spiritual knowledge imparted by the Divine. The basis of this divine knowledge is based on four pillars. The first and foremost is truth - means a measure, which was universally good. Second is austerity - means to focus on something higher than outward distractions. Third is wisdom - means to know the measures of discrimination. The fourth and the last one is chastity - means to know the measures to transform the dross of basic instincts in man. The knowledge of these four pillars in one's life can be named as Truth alone triumphs' (Satyameva Jayate). The other side of the planet which is dark can be named ignorance, based on another four pillars - attachment, anger, greed and desire.

Now, the thin layer, which segregates the entire humanity from dark to light and light to dark, is nothing but the divine knowledge. Elaborating on the notion of divine knowledge, it has been said that it (the knowledge) is divided into three different categories - acquired knowledge, intellectually grasped or ritualistically gathered knowledge and intuitive knowledge, which is the spiritual experience itself, beyond the web of mind. The divine knowledge imparted by God, the Supreme Father, differentiates between the transitory character of the materialistic path and its fleeting benefits and the permanent nature of the path of

renunciation. The spiritual practitioners see it as the prerequisite to attain real happiness. This distinction between different kinds of knowledge lies at the very heart of the divinity.

The Supreme Father, the Supreme Source of this divine knowledge, gives three beautiful similes to define the intricate relationship between the universe and the self. He says; "As a spider throws afar its web and gathers it in as well, as plants sprout on earth, as hairs grow on the human body, so does the universe emerges from the imperishable self." The cause-effect phenomenon points to the underlying origin of all the projected things, which though are real from our time-space-continuum, are also finite and limited in nature.

We should not overlook the fact that every person is, consciously or unconsciously, seeking some form of self-realization or self-actualization so that he or she can express his or her own potentialities or uniqueness, and it would, therefore, amount to denying the undeniable truth that there is a spiritual dimension of man's existence and we can overlook it at our own perils.

coming late is due to the laziness, or call it childishness. Another specially evident thing is that I do not value time, be it mine or that of others. Yet, we certainly declare that the present time, i.e., Sangam Yuga is very valuable and, so also is our life at present; but, unfortunately, we do not act up to this declaration. You will, thus, mark that many demerits lie in the womb of one bad act. In this way, how many virtues are just cast away!

Taking Service from Others

Getting others to serve us, even though we have time and ability to serve ourselves, denotes pride and also laziness on our part. It means that because of our vanity, we think that the other person is lower in status or is junior to us and, so, we can get him to serve us and it is his duty to obey us. Obviously, we behave in this way, either because we are too lazy to work or we are vain enough to think that we are not meant for these trifling jobs, which others should, therefore, do for us. But, above all, it is to be noted that all these instructions and directions, we have been getting, come from Shiva Baba Himself.

What is Avyakt Avastha?

Now, one may like to know what is meant by *Avyakt Avastha*, the ethereal state, the subtle state or the Angelic state. *Avyakt* is that which is not corporeal or earthly, nor material nor visible to

the naked eye. Hence, the term 'Avyakt Avastha' is another term for the spiritual state, because the soul is not an object of the senses but is very subtle and self-luminous. It is not a material but divine entity distinct from matter. It cannot be seen with the physical eyes. This spiritual state is incorporeal because it is bodiless. Even while having a body, we should not have any sense of materiality and that is what we mean by the detachment state, known either as Avyakt Avastha or Atmik Avastha.

Now, one has to know how that state is to be attained by means of soul-consciousness. According to God's dictum, one's state is determined by one's consciousness; one, who has the awareness that he/she is a self-luminous, sentient point of light, a child of the Supreme Soul, and that he/she has come from the land of light, called Brahmloka, to play his/her role on this corporeal world, will remain ever stable in all situations. and he/she is, therefore, spiritually blessed one. <

THE FILTRATION PROCESS IN THE SOUL

The mind and its creation, i.e., thoughts, in these times, in most people, are controlled by three main following factors:

- (I. Their habits or sanskaras
- (ii. Their past experiences, and
- (iii. The information which they are exposed to and which they imbibe.

The intellect is like a filter, which has the function of discriminating, of judging the thoughts and deciding which ones to put into practice and which ones not to, basically filtering them. Presently, the filter of the intellect has become weakened, confused and unsure; it has become blocked by many incorrect beliefs, due to which this filtration does not take place properly – as a result many wrong thoughts get converted into actions. A lot of times during the day, thoughts become actions so fast that the filter of the intellect does not even come into play, i.e., thoughts become actions bypassing the filter.

The beliefs that we have, today, are related to our cultural, physical, social, religious, political identity associated with our age, gender, occupation, wealth, role, etc. of our body. Beliefs connected to materialism, to 'having' rather than 'being', are living based on the perception of the sense organs, and not on the intuition and the wisdom of the spirit. There are the beliefs that block you or brake you, others break you, they bring about fears in you and a limited perception of reality and of yourself. However much you try to generate positive thoughts, if you do not change these beliefs, their influence on the intellect will be so strong that it is almost impossible to maintain a positive state of mind. Even if you experience it, it will be short-lived and temporary. •
